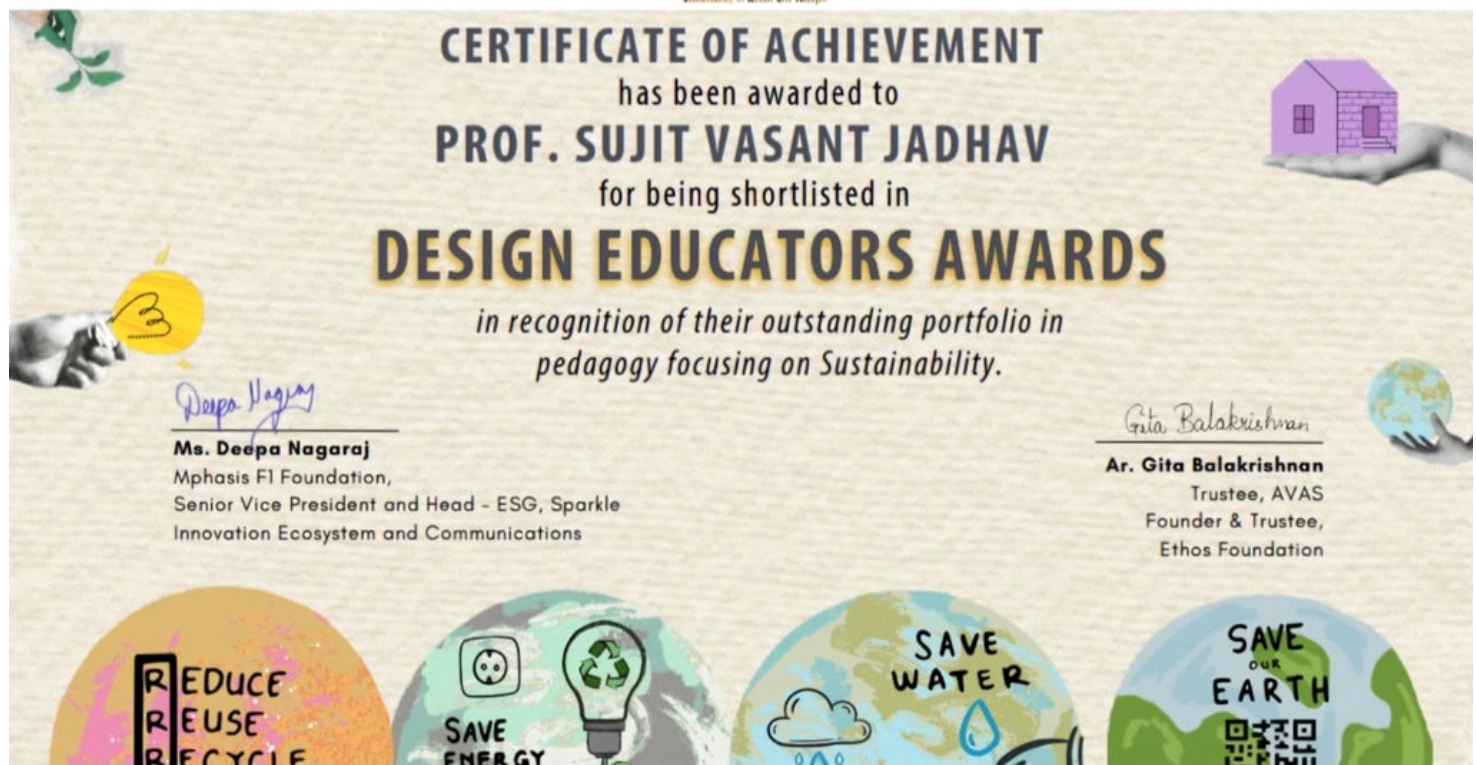

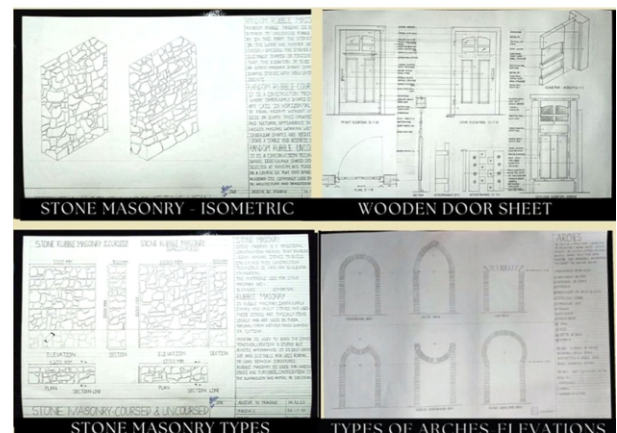

This design integrates strong steel framing, flexible polycarbonate sheets, carbon-negative concrete, and copper weather-resistant seating, ensuring durability, transparency, and comfort.
