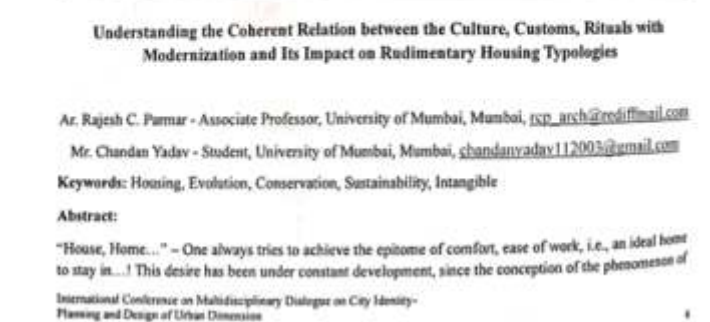
TSAP Faculty group receives recognition as Mentors
